2020 Visitor Guide

First and foremost, we're so glad you've decided to pay us a visit this summer! During these uncertain times, a visit from a friend of Mowglis is a welcome one.

The guidelines below are designed to keep **everyone** safe. It is of the utmost importance that you follow these protocols. If you don't think you'll feel safe or aren't comfortable following one or more rules, let us know so we can try to reschedule your visit for a later date.

1. Before you head out, contact James Hart, our Director of Alumni Relations to coordinate your visit. For obvious reasons, we are trying to avoid overlap amongst visitors. Call 603-744-8095 280 or james@mowglis.org
2. As soon as your visit is confirmed, take a moment to [review and sign our waiver](#).
3. Once you arrive at camp, head down to Gray Brother's Field. Parking will be readily identifiable. Headquarters is our official "Welcome Center".
4. Once at HQ, check-in with Nick, James, or Tommy to let us know you're here. If we're not "in the office", there will be other ways to contact us available.
5. As it relates to safety, we ask the following:
 - a. When in an outdoor space, please maintain social distance (6 ft.)
 - b. If you can't social distance, please employ the use of a mask.
 - c. Wash your hands well and often (sing the first verse of the *Hiking Song*).
 - d. We'll have hand sanitizer placed all over the place, please use it!
6. At this time, we are **not** accommodating overnight guests. We ask that all visitors depart by sundown.
7. Visitors under 18 must be accompanied by and actively supervised by a parent or guardian.
8. Otherwise, enjoy our beautiful campus, be safe, and Good Hunting!
